


INTRO

Connect. Serve. Give.


We ask each of our family member to be unified around 3 simple commitments as we seek to live out our mission and plan.

 - 3. Give generously & joyfully







MONEY SPENT

>> Each year, the Ethos Leadership Team, Staff, and Finance Team work diligently to spend money in a way that honors Jesus, serves the Ethos Family, and blesses the world around us. Our goal is to allocate half of our budget each fiscal year towards meeting the needs of the Ethos Family (i.e. rent, staffing, ministry, etc) and half of our budget towards meeting the needs of people locally and globally. We commonly refer to this at Ethos as the 50in/50out principal. By God's grace, we have exceeded this goal each year of our church's existence. The chart below reflects our spending for 2012.



In addition, the Ethos Staff raised \$70,000 externally in 2012 to help meet the salary needs that were not met in the weekly contribution at Ethos. The Ethos Staff has joyfully agreed to raise funds externally whenever needed so that our church can continue to give away half of our budget each year. WHERE DOES YOUR MONEY GO?

Staffing

- >> Helps provide 60% of the total salary of Ethos Staff (other 40% is raised externally).
- >> The average church our size has 22 Full Time Staff
- >> Ethos has a total of 6.5 full time staff (5 full time staff & an additional 10 part time staff that make up an additional 1.5 full time staff positions).
- >> Your generosity with your time & money allows us to keep a small staff while serving a large church family.

Sundays

- >> Provide 2 wonderful venues and space for 2,164 people to worship God each Sunday
- >> Provide Bibles and resources for thousands each week
- >> Provide a non-threatening atmosphere for people to hear the gospel every Sunday

Kids

>> Renovated the Kids space in 2012
>> Launched 5 new classrooms & new curriculum
>> Served 121 different kids in 2012


